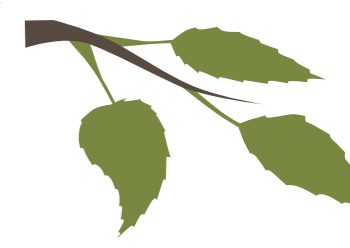
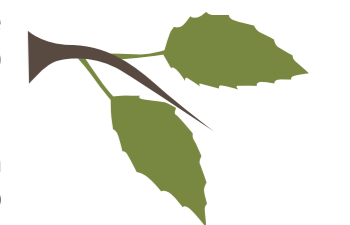
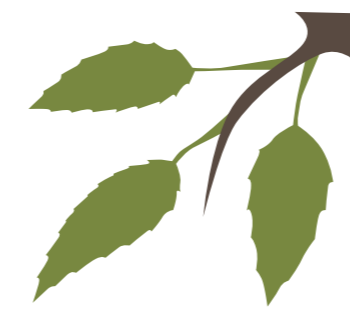
Artist statement

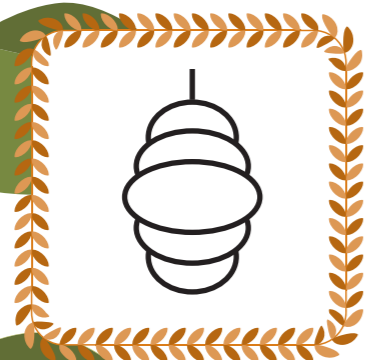

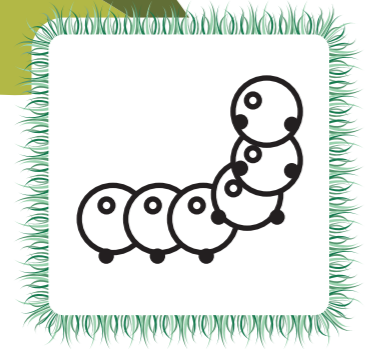
